Abstract: Psoriasis is a chronic autoimmune condition that manifests as red, scaly patches on the skin. Homoeopathy provides significant relief in managing psoriasis. This report discusses the case of a 30 - year - old female having chronic psoriasis. Based on the totality of symptoms and repertorisation, Mercurius Solubilis (Merc Sol) was prescribed.

1. Introduction

Psoriasis is characterized by:

- Red, scaly patches on the skin
- Itchiness and discomfort

Types of Psoriasis:

- **Plaque Psoriasis:** The most common form, characterized by red patches covered with silvery scales.
- Guttate Psoriasis: Small, drop shaped lesions.
- **Inverse Psoriasis:** Red patches in body folds.
- **Pustular Psoriasis:** White pustules surrounded by red skin.
- Erythrodermic Psoriasis: Widespread redness and scaling.

Symptoms of Psoriasis may include:

- Red patches of skin covered with thick, silvery scales
- Dry, cracked skin that may bleed
- Itching, burning, or soreness
- Thickened, pitted, or ridged nails
- Swollen and stiff joints

Common homeopathic remedies for psoriasis include Arsenicum Album, Graphites, Sulphur, Mercurius Solubilis, and Sepia, selected based on individualization and repertorisation.

2. Case Report

Chief Complaint:

• A 30 - year - old female presented with chronic red, scaly patches on the skin, predominantly on the underarms, for the past five years.

History of Present Complaint:

• Symptoms started five years ago with small, itchy red patches, which gradually spread and coalesced to form larger plaques.

Modalities:

- Aggravation: Cold weather, stress, skin injuries
- Amelioration: Warm weather, moisturizing the skin

Analysis and Evaluation of Symptoms:

- Mental general: Anxious and self conscious about her appearance, especially in social situations
- Physical general: Sweats excessively, especially at night; sensitive to temperature changes

Particular Symptoms:

- 1) Skin Red, scaly patches
- 2) Skin Itchiness and discomfort
- 3) Skin Cracks and bleeds easily
- 4) Skin Aggravated by cold weather and stress
- 5) Nails Thickened and ridged
- 6) Sweats Profuse, especially at night

Repertorial Result (using Synergy Software 2021, Complete Repertory):

- Merc Sol: 28/10
- Ars Alb: 25/8
- Graph: 23/7
- Sulph: 20/6

Prescription: Mercurius Solubilis 200

Selection of Medicine and Potency:

- Based on repertorisation and consultation with Materia Medica.
- Dose selected according to patient susceptibility, which remains high in chronic conditions (Organon of Medicine, 5th edition).

Potency and Repetition:

Following Organon of Medicine, Aphorism 245 - 251, 5th edition: Medicine repeated as needed, initially three times a day.

Follow - up

Time	Condition	Prescription
1 week	Reduced itching and redness, less scaling	Merc Sol 200 TID
2 weeks	Significant reduction in plaques, decreased discomfort	Merc Sol 200 TID
1 month	80% improvement, skin much clearer	Placebo TDS

Overview of Mercurius Solubilis

- Primarily affects the skin and mucous membranes.
- Symptoms include excessive sweating, particularly at night.
- Red, scaly patches with a tendency to crack and bleed.
- Aggravation from cold and damp weather, as well as from mental stress.
